

Scholarships for International Students



Taiwan Fellowships & Scholarships (TAFS)

The TAFS program is funded by joint governmental departments (Ministry of Science and Technology, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Education, Ministry of Culture, and Ministry of Economic Affairs). It comprises 9 awards in 3 categories: Fellowships, Huayu (Mandarin) Enrichment Scholarships, and Scholarships for Degree. Approximately 1,250 grants are provided annually for undergraduate and postgraduate students, as well as researchers across the world to study or to conduct advanced research in Taiwan.

Entrance Scholarships for Outstanding New Students

Guidelines:

1. The quota and amount of scholarship is subject to the school's annual budget. The grant may cover all tuition and fees, dormitory accommodation, school canteen meals, or a monthly stipend of NT\$5,000 per month (for a maximum of nine months a year), excluding student group insurance, uniforms, and other incidental expenses.
2. The quota and amount of the scholarship is decided by the Admissions Committee upon review and approval.

Publicly-funded Program

Guidelines:

1. Eligibility: Department of Nursing first year (or above) students; others departments limited to third and fourth graders.
2. Grade provisions: Applicants must achieve an academic score of 75 or above, plus a conduct grade of 80 or above. The number of years of compulsory service after graduation is the same as the number of years of contracting.
3. The awardees will gain a full tuition and fees exemption, free dormitory accommodation, free school canteen meals, and a monthly stipend.

Emergency Relief Fund for Students

It aims to assist distressed students to complete their studies. The quota and amount of the funds is subject to exceptional circumstances. The relief funds are granted on an occasional basis with a one-time subsidy paid on the very same cause. The directions for dispensation are as follows. First, the deceased or gravely injured or ill parent of the applicant is the family breadwinner, and the other parent has no income. The maximum subsidy is NT\$10,000 in principle. Second, the single-parent students fall distressed due to the fact that the family breadwinner is deceased, gravely injured, or taken ill. The maximum aid is NT\$15,000 in principle. Third, given the decease of both parents or students by accident, the maximum subsidy is NT\$20,000 in principle. Fourth, given other emergency incidents that occur and are verified by home visits, the relief funds or other aids will be dispensed according to the circumstances with discretion.

Merit Scholarship

The top 5 exemplary students in the class are selected to receive the scholarship on the basis of outstanding academic achievement. The qualified individuals are awarded NT\$20,000 each semester. The first in class is granted dormitory accommodation and canteen meals for free.

Public Scholarship for Overseas Chinese Students of Financial Difficulties (granted by the Ministry of Education)

The quota and amount of scholarship/financial aid is subject to the Ministry of Education. The students with the governmental scholarship cannot apply for this scholarship concurrently.

An amount of NT\$5,000 with a certificate will be awarded to the winner. The quota aid is subject to the Overseas Community Affairs Council. The students with the governmental scholarship cannot apply concurrently.
